Minimum Requirements

Required: Associate of Arts degree and six years of experience in fire technology. Must have sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students.

Preferred: Bachelor's or Master's degree. Five years of experience in fire technology. Experience with fire training and supervision. Ability to instruct Fire Officer Classes. Current technology skills related to teaching in the discipline and a willingness to pursue future technological developments.

General Description: Coordination of the Fire Technology program and Fire Academy. Instruction of fire technology classes such as: Fire Protection Organization, Fire Behavior and Combustion, Fire Prevention Technology, Fire Protection Equipment and Systems, Building Construction for Fire Protection, Fire Fighting Tactics and Strategy, Hazardous Materials, Fire Apparatus and Equipment.

Essential Functions: The professor will be expected to provide instruction in accordance with established course outlines and expectations; inform students about course requirements, evaluation procedures and attendance policy; maintain required student attendance and scholastic records; prepare and grade class assignments and examinations; maintain regular office hours as required; participate in the development of curriculum; participate in the development of teaching-learning methods and materials; and participate in departmental, divisional and campus professional activities/committees. Like all other faculty members at Merced College, the professor is expected to participate in the college's outcomes assessment program, including course, program, institutional assessments, revisions and developments.

Career Technical Education Area: Fire Technology is part of the Career Technical Education Area which consists of Agriculture, Industrial Technology and Business.

Interview Information: A limited number of candidates will be invited to interviews, which includes a 15-minute teaching demonstration on a selected topic. It is anticipated that interviewing will be scheduled the ~~week of April 20~~. Expenses for travel and accommodations will be the responsibility of the candidates.
