The State Training and Education Advisory Committee (STEAC) to the California State Fire Marshal is investigating the appropriateness of online instruction for Level 1 courses.

As a registered Level 1 instructor, you are the expert in presenting these courses and your input is vital as STEAC goes through the process of identifying course content that could possibly be taught online. The survey will identify which learning domains (LD), if any, you believe **require face-to-face instruction**. This will help determine what parts of the course must be taught in the classroom.

Directions:

1. Complete a survey for each Level 1 course you have taught within the last two years.
2. List the complete course title.
3. Indicate how the course could be delivered – classroom only, both classroom and online (hybrid), or entirely online.
4. For each course you checked for a hybrid delivery, list each learning domain that you believe requires face-to-face instruction. Use the topics from the course outline when listing the learning domain.
5. Identify the number of hours necessary to teach this learning domain in the classroom.

If the learning domain is not listed, it will be considered appropriate for online instruction. Make as many copies of the survey as you need for the courses you have taught within the last two years. The survey can also be downloaded from the web at CFTDA.org.
